

4th Edition Orona Get Up Awards

Orona created Orona Get Up awards to promote research among young graduate students that have a university degree. These awards recognise the projects involved in research activities, and at the same time they contribute to give solutions to the vertical transport field, urban mobility and energetic management at buildings.

Two students of the Faculty of Engineering at Mondragon Unibertsitatea have been awarded with the 1st and 2nd prize of this 4th edition.

1st Prize:

The project of the engineer Aritz Marquinez Remon of the Faculty of Engineering at Mondragon Unibertsitatea, entitled "Diseño de banco de ensayos de ascensor a escala" has been awarded as the Best Project. This project is rewarded with 1.500 €.

The objective of this project is to design one testing workbench for a scale lift, to analyze the performance of the lift, in order to alter that performance and see the repercussion of the lift. The main objective is to reach a predictive maintenance to offer the best service to the users.

2nd Prize

The 2nd prize of 1.000 € has gone to the engineer Iker Juanena Sanchez of the Faculty of Engineering at Mondragon Unibertsitatea, for the project "Herramienta de análisis energetico de ascensores".

Iker developed a tool to measure and record the energetic consume of an Orona lift installation, and also to know the energetic classification according to international standards. The minimization of the consumed energy at the lifts is a strategic element for Orona.
