Mondragon Unibertsitatea delivered the diplomas to the first graduated students of the Master in Electric Energy

Energy is one of the key sectors in the Basque economy because of its volume and its strategic importance. However, the growth and competitiveness of this sector is restricted because of the lack of highly qualified personnel. Thus, this master programme was designed to give an answer to the needs of specialized training in this sector and alleviate the gap between the existing offer and the demand.

The new edition of this master programme is going to start in March 2014 and it is for professionals who want to specialize in knowledge areas related to electrical energy and power electronics. During the first edition, 13 professionals from five companies have concluded the master programme; another 20 professionals took part in the modules of the programme and more than 200 attended the conferences.
