

The Faculty of Humanities and Education will work with the Basque Government in the management of "Lehen Aukera" grants

The Faculty of Humanities and Education, along with the other faculties of Mondragon University, are working with the Basque Government in the management of *Lehen Aukera* grants. These funds, managed by the Lanbide Basque Employment Service, aims to improve the employability of unemployed youth through work experience.

The finance will be used to hire trainees aged between 16 and 30 who are unemployed, with no or little work experience in jobs related to their qualifications, as a means of improving the employability of young people.

Beneficiaries must meet the following requirements: be unemployed and registered as job seekers in Lanbide Basque Employment Service and be identifiable on their database and have previously demonstrated compliance with the requirements of system access (under 25 years).

As "implementing partner" Mondragon University, through its Counselling Service will provide stakeholders with the opportunity to enrol as unemployed in Lanbide and inform them about *Lehen Aukera* program. In addition, the university will provide support for those companies able to offer employment.
