The requirements of the contest are:

- The video must be recorded with a phone.
- The video should last between 30 and 60 seconds.

- The contest is open to all students and employees of the Faculty of Humanities and Education.

How would you encourage the use of Basque in HUHEZI?

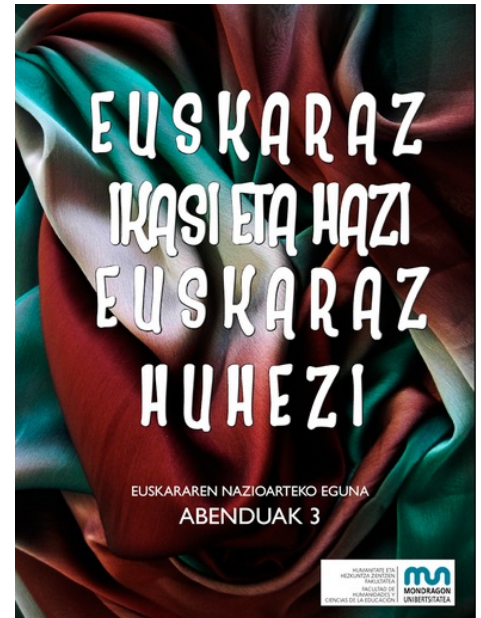
- Proposals should be sent to the Commission of Euskara of the Faculty at the following address:
