

## Contest winners at 37th Basque Film Awards in Lekeitio are former students and a teacher from Audiovisual Communication degree

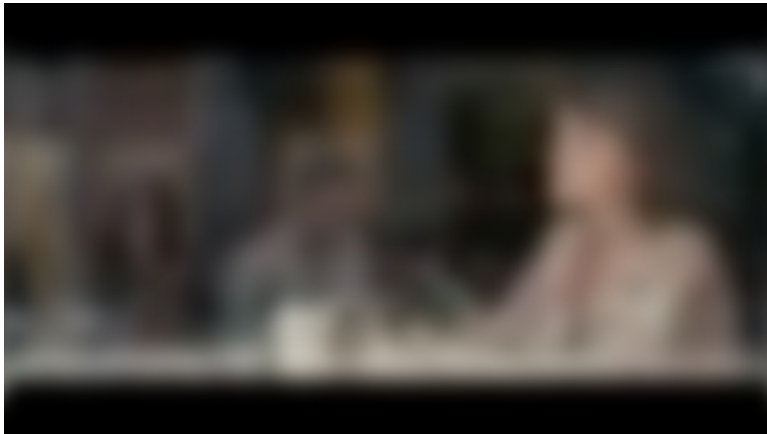
