Last week it took place in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, the kick-off meeting of this new Erasmus Mundus project, <http://www.interweave-ema2.eu/>. Coordinated by École Centrale de Nantes, France, and co-coordinated by University of Malaya, Malaysia, this project will allow mobility in both directions between European and Asian universities. The possibilities are both for exchange and to obtain the Degree at the host university.

In particular, European students and staff from partner universities will have from 1 month to 3 years stays at universities of Malaysia (co-coordinator), China, India, Thailand, Bangladesh, Nepal, Bhutan and Indonesia. Asian students will have the opportunity to apply to European partner universities in France, Estonia, Latvia, Poland, Germany, United Kingdom, Italy, Portugal and Spain.
